In 1928, Vernon Payne was teaching students at the Aviation Service and Transport Company aircraft school in Chicago. In an effort to make the classes more interesting for the students, he changed the topic to minimum-sized sport airplanes. By the time class was over, there was a rough sketch on the black-board of a tiny biplane. This was the beginning of what would become the Knight Twister. The aircraft went through many variants over the years, with four versions currently being offered by Steen Aero Lab.
